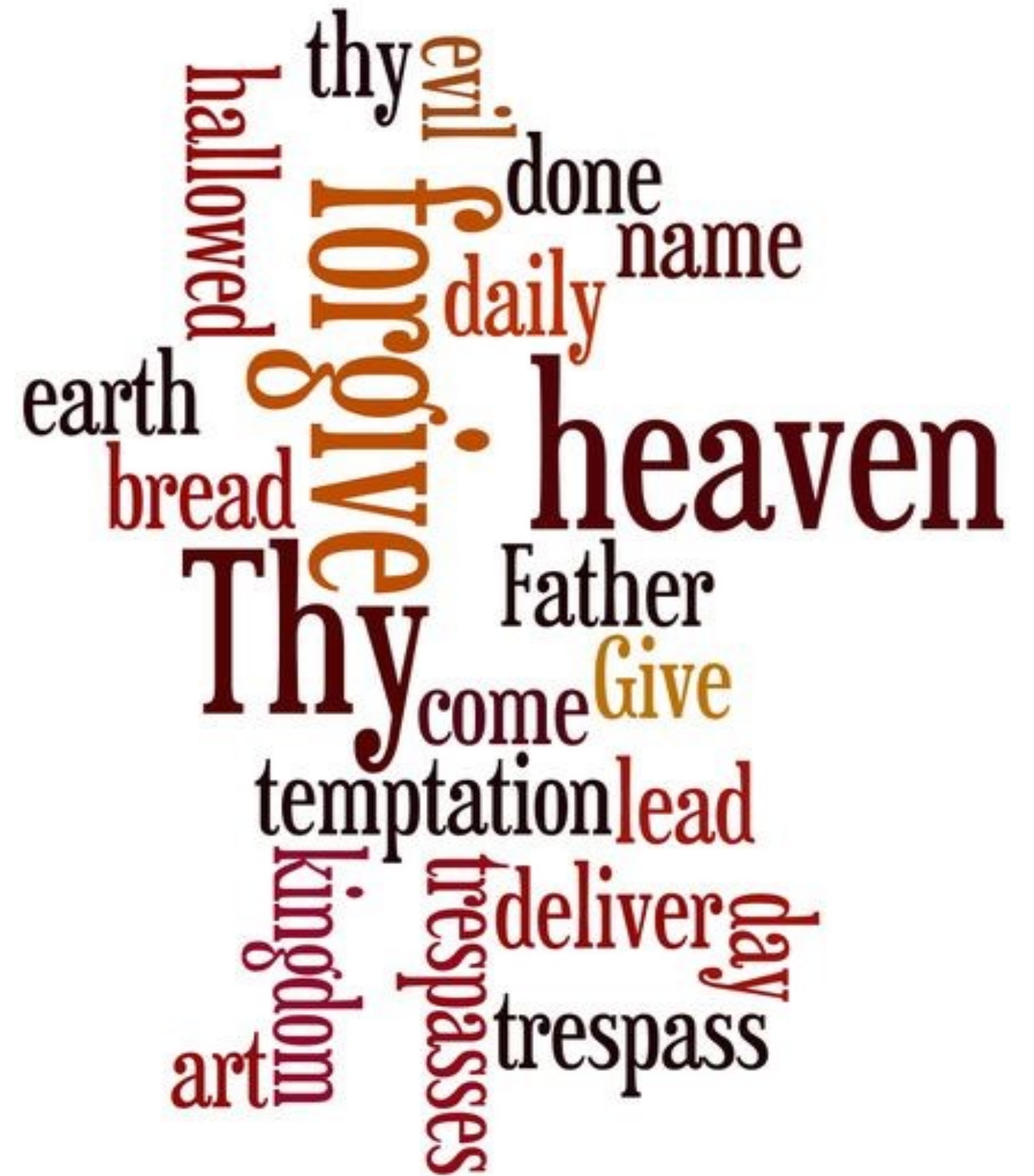

### CareNet Pregnancy Center

Care Net provides free and confidential pregnancy services for women and their families. Care Net will walk alongside of you from your initial appointment to your pregnancy test or ultrasound, all the while providing you with essential information you need to make a decision that is right for you. All our services are confidential and come at no cost for those who need it.

### Food Pantry of Indian River County

The first Sunday of each month is food Sunday. Please bring non-perishable foods to help keep our food pantry stocked. The Food Pantry of Indian River County is here to insure that any resident in our community who needs food is able to receive it. The Food Pantry is located at the north end of our Educational Building B.

### Indian River County Sports Ministry

This group provides sports teams, leagues and organizations with a chaplain, who is embedded within the coaching staff to serve as a character guide for athletes and coaches. The ministry is designed to help athletes and coaches foster/build a strong Christian faith-based relationship with Jesus Christ.

### Little Birthday Angels

Bringing birthday joy to children experiencing homelessness. With the helping hands of our community, we are celebrating one homeless child's birthday at a time.

### Mission Offerings

### Operation Christmas Child

The mission of Operation Christmas Child is to demonstrate God's love in a tangible way to children in need around the world. Through this project, Samaritan's Purse partners with the local church worldwide to share the Good News of Jesus Christ and make disciples of the nations.

### Risk Takers For Christ

Each Monday evening at 6:00 PM, you will find Risk Takers staff & volunteers in our gym. They are engaging as many as 60 at-risk young (youth) men in a healthy game of basketball. While there, they distribute free bottles of cold water and sports-themed gospel literature. Most importantly, they demonstrate God's love and true manhood in tangible ways.

### Samaritan Center (Soup Bowl)

Soup Bowl originated more than 30 years ago when the Samaritan Center Advisory Board brainstormed ideas on a community fundraiser that would bring awareness of the homeless population and would be affordable enough for everyone to attend. From that meeting, Soup Bowl was born. The minimum donation continues to be \$5 for a bowl of soup, \$15 for a quart container of 'soup-to-go'. They also sell pottery bowls handmade by local potters; however, the idea is to donate what you would have spent on that meal had you gone out to eat instead.

### Wednesday Friends

Every Wednesday we serve 30-50 people at our Wednesday Friends ministry. They are able to get needed clothing, blankets & other items before they hear a wonderful message and have dinner. We have several volunteers who help in the clothing room & in the dining area. If you are interested in volunteering your time for this worthwhile ministry, please see Paul Schlicht. If you are able, please donate blankets, towels, linens, bug spray & deodorant. Your generosity to this vital ministry is greatly appreciated.

### Youth For Christ

YFC exists to build Christ-sharing relationships with students who do not have a relationship with Jesus. They don't know that God loves them, and they think Christianity is boring and out of date. They face lives filled with peer pressure, drugs, alcohol, and relationships that are twisted and distorted from what God originally intended. They don't go to church. YFC builds Christ-sharing relationships with those students. We pursue them wherever they are. We spend time with them and listen to them, earning the right to be heard when it comes to what really matters in life: Knowing God and being known and loved by God.

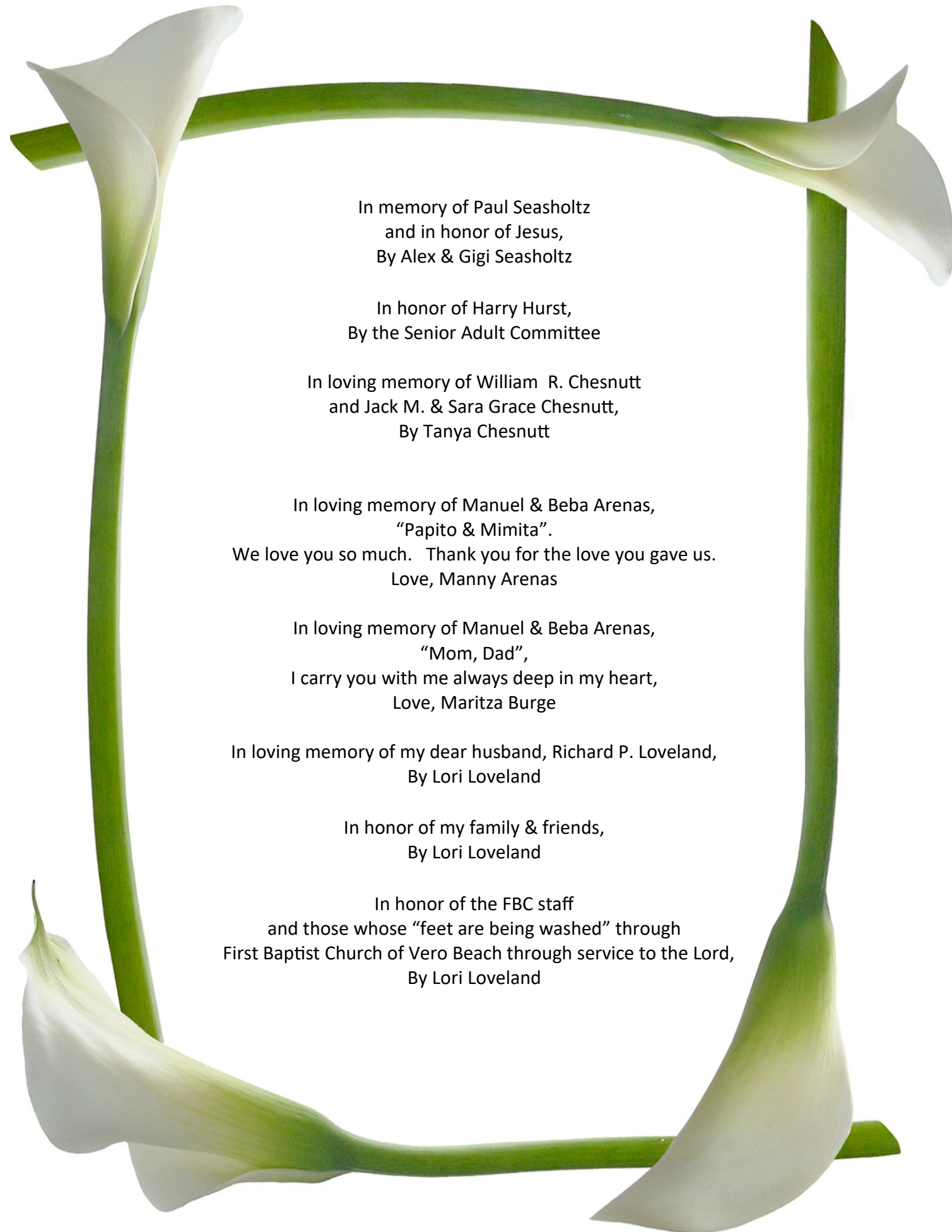

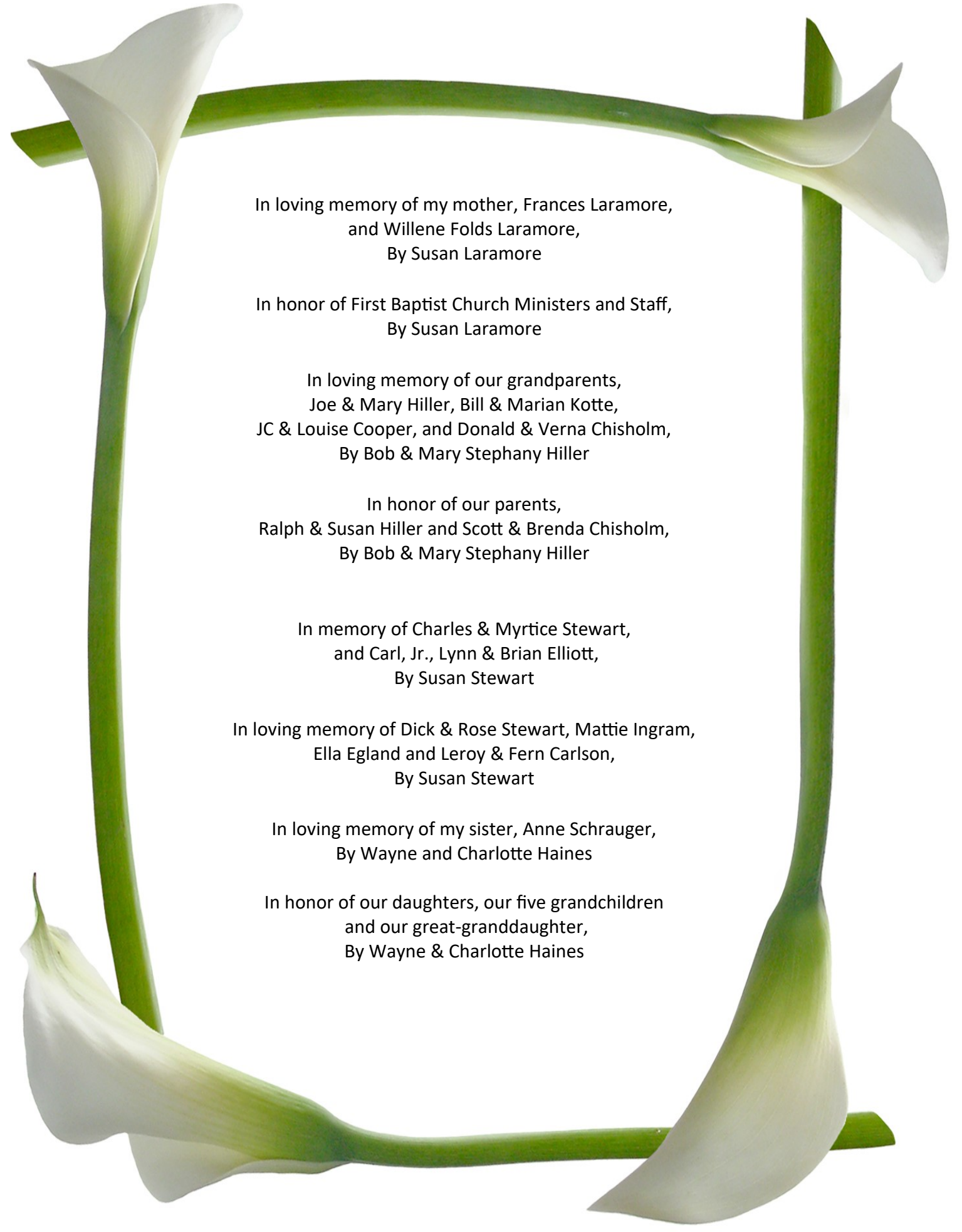
